



Instructions for those gathering for the Sunday Service.

1. Please follow all instructions given by the Stewards.
2. Attendees displaying Covid19 symptoms (high temperature, continuous cough, lost/altered sense of taste/smell) should return home and follow government guidelines.
3. Attendees of same household as symptomatic person should return home and follow government guidelines.
4. Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to the service start time.



5. Attendee households to maintain 2m social distancing from others where possible, within the building. Children must remain within their household and be supervised.
6. Please make use of hand sanitisers on entry to and exit from the building.
7. Disabled toilet is for emergency use only and for one household at a time. Children must be accompanied. Wash your hands and re-use sanitiser. Please clean after, as instructions
8. Please remain seated in the chairs allocated upon entry. Please do not move or swap chairs.



9. Attendees to wear face masks throughout the service (unless leading service, or those who are exempt as per Gov. guidance).
10. There will be no public offering, please contact the leaders for information on giving.
11. Currently, no public singing is allowed although you may wish to use the sung words as a silent prayer.
12. No social interaction is permitted between household groups. e.g., talking.
13. Only Entrance Hall, Hall 1 are available for use. Disabled toilet is for emergency use only.
14. After the service, please only leave when stewards direct you to, and leave promptly, not lingering in the Entrance Hall.



15. Personal items (e.g., coats and bags) to be kept with their owners.
16. No shared food is permissible.
17. Attendees reminded to follow government guidance if in high-risk/shielding categories (up to individuals to choose how to manage their own risk).
18. Fire regulations - as per existing fire risk assessment with the addition to refrain from physical contact outside of households/support bubbles, remaining 2m apart where possible.
19. Names and contact details taken of all attendees for government track and trace system. Data held for 21 days.
